² Section 10.301.1(b) of the Election Law Article of the *Annotated Code of Maryland* specifies the number of early voting centers for each county. If a county has less than 150,000 registered voters, the county shall have one early voting center. If a county has more than 150,00 but fewer than 300,000 registered voters, the county shall have three early voting centers. If a county has more than 300,000 registered voters, the county shall have five early voting centers.
